6 Ask your teacher if you can use tally marks to make a graph of shoe sizes for your class.

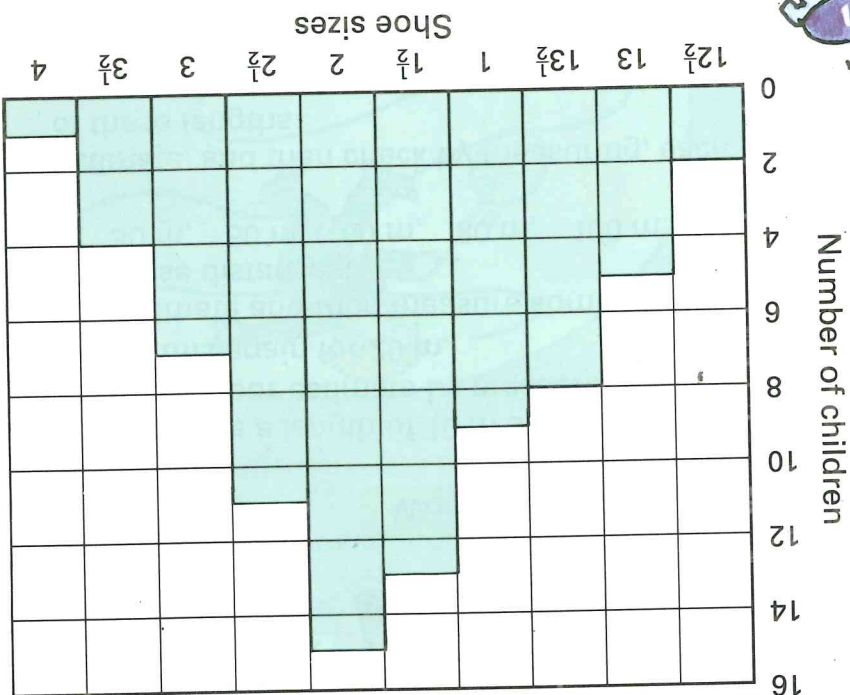
