



Problems

- 2 A tin of noodles weighs 205 grams. What is the weight of 48 tins?
- 3 Dog meat costs 29p per tin. Mary bought a carton of 32 tins. How much change did she receive from £10?

- 4 (a) Lorna swam 37 breadths of the pool. How far did she swim?
- (b) Jim swam 17 lengths of the pool. How much further would he have to swim to complete 1000 metres?



- 5 Mr Scott earns £185 per week. Mr Welsh earns £800 each month. Who earns more in a year and by how much?
- 6 Twenty-one boxes containing 138 apples, and another box containing 102 apples, were delivered to a superstore. How many apples were delivered altogether?
- 7 Mrs Brown saves £20 every month. How much will she have saved after 5 years?



- 8 The theatre has 23 rows of 28 seats downstairs and 16 rows of 32 seats upstairs.
 - (a) What is the total number of seats in the theatre?
 - (b) How many more seats are there downstairs than upstairs?
 - (c) All the tickets are sold for a charity concert. If the cost of a ticket is £8, how much is collected for the charity?
