# Charges & Remissions

The Board of Governors affirms that all compulsory subjects will be provided free of charge.

The Governors will, however, invoke 'The Education Reform (N.I.) Order 1989', to request voluntary contributions equal to the full per capita cost in respect of Music Tuition, Examination Fees for music, Educational Visits or any other activity which the school is not legally obliged to provide.

No pupil will be omitted from the above because of parental refusal to meet the per capita cost of same but it is hoped that such instances would be minimal.

Where appropriate, the Board of Governors may subsidise part of the cost of the activity out of school funds. On occasions the PTA may also help to subsidise the per capita cost of Educational Visits.
