A few gentle reminders

Whilst the presentation of school uniform is a general strength this is a good time of year to recap - children should come to school in **full school uniform**. This includes **black footwear**. Black school shoes must be worn when your child represents the school. Taking pride in our appearance shows **pride in our school**. PE kit should be a white polo t-shirt, **plain navy** shorts or **plain navy** tracksuit bottoms (**not black**). If your child is unable to attend school, please phone in the morning to let the teacher know, and ensure a **note** is sent explaining their absence **immediately** upon their return.

School dinner costs £3.10 per day. **Dinner money should be paid on Monday in a clearly marked envelope** with your child's name and the days they intend to have dinners.

Please remember **pupils will not be supervised before 8:45am in the morning**. Children dropped off early, should go to Breakfast Club in Pre-School (from 8:15am), charged at £1.50 per day. I am sure you will appreciate this rule is to ensure the safety and well-being of your children.
