Dear Parents / Guardians,

Remote Learning

As a school we want to maximise face to face teaching for pupils, remote learning will be the last resort, only if dictated by our Risk Assessments.

In the event of remote learning for a short period of time due to staff absence, a pack has been sent home and via Seesaw, parents will be communicated with when they need to be used.

In the case of longer spells of remote learning for whole class or school, Seesaw tasks will then be used more predominantly with online tools such as video tutorials, Teams, Mathletics etc. Hopefully this never happens but in this case, laptops will be available for collection for those who meet the criteria.

Please ensure that your child is able to access their Seesaw Class account and you as a Parent are able to access Seesaw Family account. We use Seesaw regularly in our school and it is important that all our families can access Seesaw.

For children isolating at the request of guidelines by St Theresa's Board of Governors, worksheets that are being completed in school can be provided by the teacher. Contact the school office to avail of these.

Free School Meals

Children who are isolating and are entitled to Free School Meals, can receive a food parcel to the value of a FSM for the required number of days. Please contact the school if you wish to avail of this facility.
