Board of Management Meeting - Agreed Report
February 21st, 2023

A Board of Management meeting took place on Tuesday, February 21st, 2023.

The following is the agreed report that emerged from the meeting.

Morning Drop-Off:

Parental support for the arrangements regarding morning drop-off was noted. It was agreed that we should continue with the initial suggestions:

- Be mindful of other drivers and try not to hold up traffic. If you have to wait, please try to move your car to a spot where the flow of traffic, in the outer lane of the set-down area, is not being blocked.
- Do not park outside the railings of the set-down area. Parking outside the railings obstructs the view of drivers who are trying to exit the set-down area.

One further suggestion emerged from this meeting:

- Please escort your child/children to the school gate in the mornings.

Thank you for your cooperation to date and we will continue to work together to create the safest environment we can for dropping your children off to school.

Library Books:

As previously reported, the Board has received Department of Education funding for the purchase of library books. Work has continued on the procurement process for the selection and sourcing of these books. The Board is delighted to report that the process is nearing completion and that most of the books have been delivered to the school. A small amount of the grant remains unspent but it is planned to purchase titles from the Barrington Stoke collection with the remaining funds. The books will be displayed as part of World Book Day celebrations and introduced to the classrooms thereafter. The Board hopes that the new books bring joy and pleasure to the children and foster a love of reading for years to come
