#### <u>Important</u>

Time keeping is so important in Nursery. If your child is late they miss so much at the beginning of their day. Morning circle time is the time when we share news and ideas. We discuss the rules of the nursery and what is happening that day. <u>Nursery 1</u> doors open at 9am and <u>Nursery 2</u> 8.45am please adhere to these times. At collection time if you are late your child can become upset when the other children have left. Nursery 1 finish 1.15pm/Nursery 2 finish 1pm. These times are always under review as we follow Department of Education, PHA and Education Authority guidance.

#### Outdoor Play

We will still be playing outside in the winter months. Before we go outside each child puts a coat on, these coats are provided by school. Please help your child to practise putting on a coat at home. If you want your child to wear a hat outside please send a hat that can STAY in school into your child's class teacher. Please ensure their name is on it.

#### Face coverings

Please remember to wear a face covering and to keep a 2 metre distance from other parents and children when dropping off AND picking up your child.

## Reminder

- Morning: Doors open at 8.45am (N2) and 9.00a.m.(N1).
- Please continue to follow the rules in place to limit the spread of Covid-19. If you are waiting at the gate/in playground we would ask that you continue to allow a distance between you and others in the queue and that you wear a face covering.
- If you do arrive early/late either in the morning or the afternoon please remember that you will have to wait outside the gate until the other class "bubble " has gone into school and all the parents have left. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

- Only staff members are to open side gate. If you are late please buzz at main door and a staff member will then open side gate.
- Please ensure school fund/dinner envelopes are completed before dropping children at the door as this can cause congestion at the classroom and unsettle the children.
