Colour of the month: purple

Our theme for May

Our topic this month is "People who help us" and our colour focus is purple.

This term is very busy in nursery! Please make sure you keep checking seesaw regularly for messages and important information.

Sickness in School

Please remember if your child is sick keep them at home and inform school as soon as possible of illness. If your child is on antibiotics they should have had at least 48 hours of the dose before returning to school.

Upset tummy/sickness-child must be kept at home for 48 hours after last episode.

Care in the Sun (fingers crossed!!!!) and Outdoor Safety

During warm weather we like our children to have extended outdoor play.

- Please apply sunscreen to your child BEFORE coming into school.
- Leave a sunhat in school for daily use, please remember to put your child's name on the hat.
- Suitable footwear at all times- Some types of sandals can be dangerous for our outside play, especially climbing and balancing activities. Please make sure your child wears suitable footwear to school so that accidents can be avoided. NO flip flops please, they are too dangerous for outside play
- Parents often ask about a 'summer uniform'. We are happy to see the girls in summer school dresses (usually red check) and shorts for boys/girls.
- As the weather begins to warm up in the forthcoming weeks, children will be taking their sweatshirts off more and more. Please make sure your child's sweatshirt is clearly named as it is very hard for staff to sort out a mix up if they are not named. Please remember to check the name tabs from time to time to make sure they survive after washing.

Snack/School fund and dinner money

Please remember that snack/school fund (£3.50) and dinner money (£12.50.) should be paid promptly every **MONDAY** morning using the brown envelopes provided by the school. Please mark your child's name clearly on this envelope. We would ask that you have the correct amount of money please as change cannot be given.
