

St. Michael's College, Mount Lourdes G.S., ERGs. All applications should be made directly to SEAG website. St. Joseph's is unable to apply on your behalf. Application packs are currently available from these schools. Further information is also available via their websites.

Free School Meals

If you feel your child is entitled to free school meals, it is vitally important that you make an application to the Education Authority, to register your child. Even if your child does not

want to take school dinners please apply anyway, as this has a major impact on our school budget.
