Cooked playdough

What you need

- 2 cups plain flour
- i cup cooking salt
- 2 cups boiling water
- 2 tablespoons cooking oil
- 4 tablespoons cream of tartar

A couple of drops of food colouring

What to do

- Place all the dry ingredients except the food colouring into a bowl
- 2. Add boiling water to the oil and food colouring
- Add the wet mix to the dry ingredients and mix well.
- 4. Knead the dough until smooth

Note: Cooked dough can be stored in a plastic bag or in an airtight container in the fridge for up to two months.

Ideas to try

Play dough can be used with a rolling pin and cookie cutters, assorted plastic lids, a butter knife
for cutting segments, a muffin tray, a garlic press, plastic bottle tops and whatever you have
handy at home.
