Is wiggle all night,

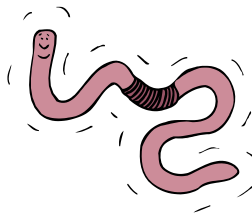
And wiggle all day,

I love Mrs Bunny cos she's so neat.

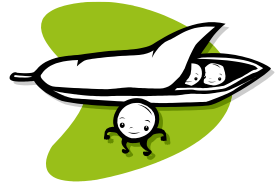
Mrs Bunny stretches, Mrs Bunny flops,

Mrs Bunny hops and hops and hops, and Mrs Bunny hops and stops.



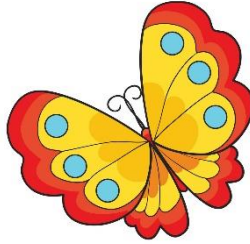
4. 5 Little Peas

Until one day the pod went POP !



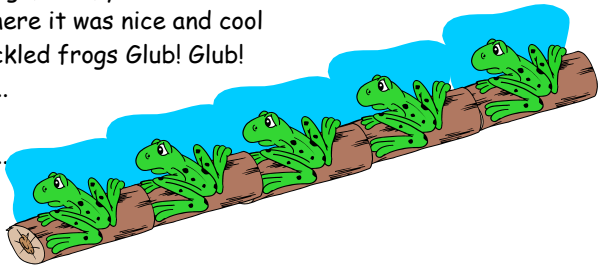
5. Butterfly, Butterfly
