How You Can Help Us and Your Child

Car Parking: Please follow the one way system in our car park and do not double park, in front of or behind the parking bays, or park directly outside main gate of school. Please refrain from parking in allocated staff spaces. Thank you.

The school will not be opened until 9.00am and 12.30pm. Please enter via the front door and bring your child to their classroom cloakroom and hand them into the care of a member of staff from their classroom. A member of staff will hand your child over at the end of the session. Please be punctual.

Wash them well, wash them well.



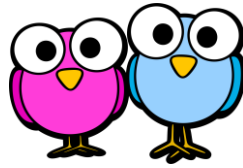
4. Two Little Eyes
