Holy Trinity College believes that the transition from Primary School to Post-Primary School must be as smooth as possible, to ensure that your son / daughter continues to progress in an environment where he / she will feel safe, feel valued, feel nurtured and most importantly, be happy. Holy Trinity College is a vibrant school and we take great pride in what we do on a daily basis. Our core business is to:

- Build on the work carried out by your son / daughter's Primary school and receive a detailed profile of your child's ability and strengths in advance of their Induction into the College.
- Assist your son/daughter to access a broad and balanced curriculum at their own pace via a range of supports in literacy, numeracy, mentoring, small group work, one-one support, organisational skills, friendship building and so on, with the help of our Learning Support Team.
- Engage with Nurture Provision in The Haven, to assist with transition to a large secondary school; preparing pupils for learning; developing social communication skills; and improving pupil wellbeing.
- Engage in a broad and balanced curriculum, where those of high academic ability can focus on obtaining up to 10 GCSEs including Further Maths, Additional Science and English Literature, in preparation for A Level Study and Third Level Education.
- Provide a more vocational route with 'hands on' practical subject experience leading to apprenticeships, particularly in Engineering, and high-quality skills for future career pathways.
- Avail of support for pupils with Autism via a range of specialist strategies within the Sensory Room and thereby provide a sanctuary to feel calm, supported and focused. These supports are extended within the Specialist Provision Learning Centre for pupils with moderate or severe learning difficulties.
 - Support pupils in Years 8, 9 and 10 with a strong background in Irish language to complete their GCSE Irish Qualification at the end of Year 10.
 - Engage with and extend learning beyond the classroom through a broad range of enrichment and extra-curricular opportunities.
