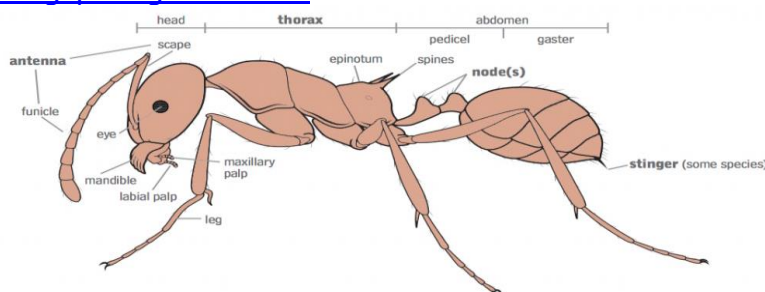
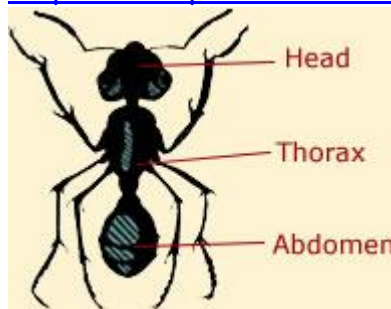
**SESE: Ants Unlocking SESE P121 DO THIS IN YOUR COPY NOT THE BOOK!**
