## Update on Coronavirus (COVID-19)

### Pupils entitled to Free School Meals

A number of our children are in receipt of free school meals. I was informed yesterday that DE intends to support these pupils by issuing payments to the main carer's account on a fortnightly basis. Final plans have yet to be sorted and someone from DE may contact these families in the coming days.

Until plans have been put in place, I have decided to continue to provide our Food Bank service which will provide enough food for one main meal per day for any child currently on our Free School Meals Register. The Food Bank will open on **Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March at 11:00am – 12:00 noon** and parents will be issued with food parcels to cater for 5 meals (1 week). Please complete the form on the school app if you would like to receive a food parcel.

### Google Classroom

Almost all children have now created their own Google Classroom account and are completing the activities set by their teacher. If you are unable to create your Google Classroom account, it is important that you make contact with your child's teacher. **Completed workbooks should be returned to school on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> April.** It is important that all completed work is forwarded to your child's teacher for the purpose of monitoring and assessment.
