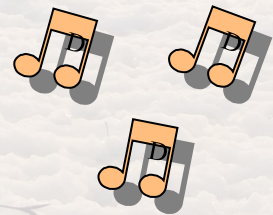

If they are prescribed an antibiotic keep your child off until finished the antibiotic as a relapse usually occurs and they benefit from the rest.
