We will know where they came from and how to look after them. We will also be making loads of paper flowers to sell in our flower shop. We will be talking about the changes we see in spring and the weather and new animals and plants. We will be painting different flowers.



Gruffalo

One of our themes this month is 'the gruffalo' children will explore the story through various aspects of play in nursery. we will make gruffalo food for 'gruffalo picnic' outdoors. We will dress up for roleplay and participate in table top activities threading and language based games.

Throughout the month we will be looking at the Shamrock shape and watching out for it. We will be playing with green materials. We will be making green play dough. You can help by looking out for and talking about shamrocks at home and elsewhere.
