NEURONIMO

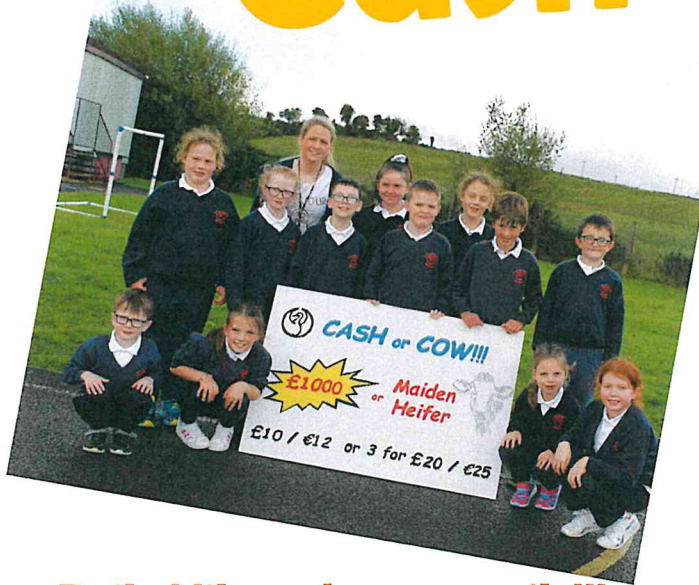

We will be following this programme over the next 12 weeks across the whole school teaching children how their bodies respond to fear, anxiety or impulsiveness and what actions they can take to manage responses and reactions.

Neuronimo is a behavioural change programme created by Reverse the Trend Foundation to help children develop and retain healthy autonomous habits around mental and physical health. The Neuronimo programme is fueled by psychology and science but with information and learning that young people can use in a real and powerful way.
