Cool For School Photography.

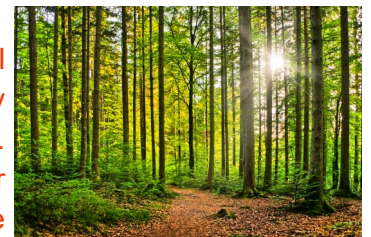
Our school photographer will be in school on 11th November to take individual photographs of the children. If you do not wish for your child to have their photograph taken please let a member of staff know.
