We very much hope that this will be true for each of our pupils.

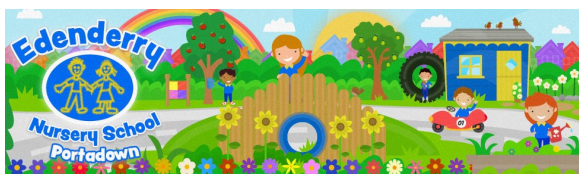
PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT.
