Learning within the Nursery School

Earth Day 2024

On Monday 22nd April 2024, we celebrated Earth Day. All the children were busy outside weeding, brushing, tidying, sorting and gardening. Thank you to Miss Johnston for taking the lead on all of this work! The children also developed their skills in marbling by creating their own earth using blue and green paint along with marbles in a tray!



We discussed the importance of looking after our world by recycling and how we put our rubbish where it belongs (blue bin, brown bin and black bin). The children were able to discuss the effects rubbish and pollution can have on our environment as well as living things. The children have been so enthusiastic about taking good care of our school grounds and have enjoyed getting the opportunity to help.

Sunflowers



All of our children planted their own sunflower and took them home in compostable pots so that they could replant them. We are looking forward to seeing the photographs on Seesaw of how tall they grow!

Gardening

As well as cleaning up our playground and planting our sunflowers, the children have been planting in the school grounds. To date, we have planted shallots, red onions, beans and brown onions. If any of you have any child friendly plants/seeds/bulbs/plastic pots/children's gardening gloves, trowels, spades etc that you would like to donate to the school for the children to use, it would be much appreciated.

Socatots and Rugbugz

All of our children have been enjoying taking part in weekly Socatots sessions with David on a Tuesday. These have been helping the children develop their balance and co-ordination skills. Weekly Rugbugz sessions with Claire will be starting on Friday 3rd May for the month of May.

Class Trips



We are delighted to be offering all of our children the opportunity of a class trip this summer. All of our pre schoolers will have the opportunity to experience a train journey from Ballymoney to Coleraine. The tickets have all been booked and our seats have been reserved with Translink to ensure we are all seated together. When we get to Coleraine, the children will have sole use of Itsy Bitsy Wonderland. Itsy

Bitsy Wonderland is a role play centre featuring 11 areas specifically designed for young children, with a variety of play equipment, toys and costumes. This will enable the children to develop their curiosity and creativity with their friends. Snack will be provided onsite and all dietary requirements will be catered for. Thank you to everyone who offered to help accompany us. Your child's class teacher will be in touch shortly to confirm if your help is required.

Our Pre-pre schoolers will be having the opportunity to explore the sensory world within Through the Looking Glass. They will walk from the Nursery school to Through the Looking Glass and then walk back to Nursery.

As you know we have been taking part in the Getting Ready to Learn programme and the feedback has been great from our weekly lending library. ⁽³⁾ During term 3, we will be alternating the book bags with activity bags each week. The activity bags will have a range of resources, developmental information and activity guidance. The bags will enrich the development of your child across the six areas of the pre-school curriculum, and will provide fun and educational experiences (as well as help you to

support your child at home!). The bags will go home on a Friday and should be returned <u>no later</u> than Tuesday of the following week.

Please note: The bags are for use with adult supervision only and should be taken care of at home. Each bag should be returned in the same way it went home and with all items included. Unwell children



In the event of your child being ill, especially with a vomiting/diarrhoea bug, please do not send him/her to school. The Public Health Agency advises that **48 hours is left** from the last episode of illness before your child returns to school. In addition, if your child is on an antibiotic they must not attend school until the course is

completed. We are aware that there are various viruses and illnesses going around at the minute, thank you to everyone who has been vigilant and kept their child at home until they have recovered.

Child Protection

If Mrs Muller or myself are unavailable, please speak with Mrs Jarvis (Deputy Designated Officer for Child Protection) or any member of staff who will relay your message on to a member of the safeguarding team.
