Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*We are learning about our emotions. This month we are focusing on "Happy" and "Sad."

Encourage your child to talk about what makes them happy and sad. The story "Owl Babies" focuses on these emotions.

Physical Development

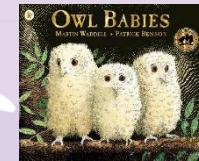
*Playing with playdough helps children develop their Fine Motor Skills and strengthen their hand muscles.

Language Development

Early Mathematical Experiences

*Help your child sort Lego/blocks/toys by colour

Ask question- *Where do the red/green ones go? Which colour has the most pieces?*



The Arts

*Talk to your child about Autumn colours; red, yellow, orange, and brown.
