Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- * Every day in Nursery the children pray for their family and relatives.
- * You could help your child to create a Christmas card for a member of their family and post it or deliver it to them to spread some Christmas cheer.



Physical Development

- * During movement breaks and outdoor play the children develop their gross motor movements in lots of ways; by skipping, hopping, rolling etc

Language Development

Early Mathematical Experiences

- * You could cut out some shapes using different coloured paper. Talk to your child about the names and properties of the shapes e.g. triangle, square, circle, star, straight, round, corners etc
