Personal, Social + Emotional

Language Development

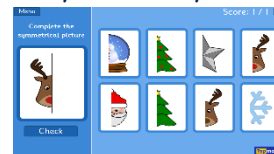
* Have a look at the Story of the First Christmas that we shared and then using the Nativity Word Mat find the familiar characters from the story. Can your child recall the story in their own words?
