Home Learning Ideas

Personal, Social + Emotional

*Pumpkins are decorated with lots of different faces, expressing different emotions. Ask your child to show you a happy, sad, silly, shocked, angry, sleepy, and grumpy face.



Physical Development

*See the *Halloween Movement Game* and challenge your child to create different Halloween themed movements.

E.g. Can you crawl like a spider?



Language Development

Mathematical Experiences
