## Home Learning Ideas

### Personal, Social + Emotional

- \* The emotions we are focusing on during the month of December are **"Surprised"** and **"Excited."**
- \* Talk to your child about different feelings that they may experience at Christmas time. Ask them to show you their surprised and excited faces.



### Physical Development

- \* The children are developing their scissor skills in Nursery.
- \* You could give your child some different types of wrapping paper and ribbons alongside some scissors. They can practise their scissor skills as they are snipping and cutting the paper.



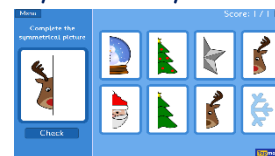
### Language Development

- \* Show your child the **Christmas "Can You Find?" Poster**.
- \* Ask questions e.g. *Can you find the bauble/gingerbread man/milk?* Etc  
Encourage your children to talk about the object that they find and their position on the poster.
