### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- \*When children learn to take turns, they are learning basic back and forth rhythms that all communication is built on.
- \*Take turns playing the game/completing the jigsaw your child received in their Home Learning Pack.  
Model language while playing:  
"Your turn...My turn...  
Your turn...My turn."

### Physical Development
