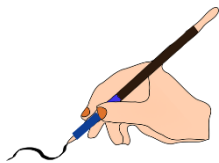
Physical Development

Language Development

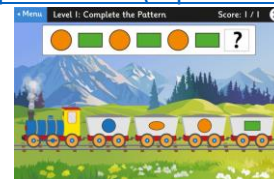
* In school we are working on identifying our own name and some of us are even trying to write it too. Encourage your child at home to recognise their name, to trace the letters and if ready maybe even write it.
