Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*In Nursery the children are learning how to share with their friends. This is one of our "Teddy Bear Rules." Talk to your child about the importance of sharing with others.

- See the Sharing Problem Picture.
Discuss with your child. What should you do?

Early Mathematical Experiences

*Cut out some paper shapes for your child: circle, triangle, rectangle, square, heart, star.

Ask questions- Can you find the heart?

Which shape is round?



-See Halloween shape picture.

Physical Development

*Pouring and Filling Activities help
children develop their spatial
awareness and hand-eye coordination.
-You could set up a box of water with
different sized bowls and spoons. Add
small toys (or Halloween items) for the
children to scoop up.



The Arts

*The children are learning the Halloween songs that were posted with the October Newsletter. Have a go at singing some of these songs at home.

-Explore some Halloween songs on YouTube



Language Development

* "Room on the Broom," is one of our favourite Halloween stories. You can listen to it on YouTube.

Ask questions- Who found the witch's hat? What did the dragon want to do? What was your favourite part of the story?



The World Around Us

*The children are learning about Halloween and festive traditions. Talk to your child about family traditions e.g. Dressing up, Trick or Treating.

-Explore the Halloween Word Mat and talk about the pictures.
