



Home Learning Ideas Week beginning 1st March 2021



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*In Nursery we talk about the importance of showing love and kindness towards our friends. -See the Discussion Cards Ask your child to identify which is a friendly or unfriendly image and why.



Early Mathematical Experiences

The children love copying patterns in Nursery. On a strip of paper draw a simple 2-colour pattern like the image below. Give your child the coloured counters from their Home Learning Pack. Ask them to copy the pattern by placing the matching counters on top. You could extend by drawing a 3 or 4 colour pattern for your child to copy.



Physical Development

*On the Farm Movement Game -See the Farm Gross Movement Cards and discuss with your child. Encourage your child to create different farm animal movements.

E.g. Can you waddle like a duck? Can you gallop like a horse?



The Arts

*Ask your child what their favourite farm animal is. Find a picture of it in a book or on the internet. Talk about how it looks: What colour is it? How many legs does it have? It is a big or a small animal? Ask your child to draw or paint their chosen animal. Encourage them to talk



about the marks they make.

Language Development



* It is World Book Day on Thursday. You could help your child create a cosy reading tent using sheets, blankets, soft toys etc. Ask your child to choose their favourite books and enjoy reading them together in their World Book Day Reading Den!

The World Around Us

Talk to your child about animals that live on the farm. Talk about the names of their babies. Discuss new vocabulary e.g. A calf is a baby cow.
