Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*This week we are celebrating St Patrick's Day. Talk about what a celebration is: a special day or event that we look forward to. Discuss other celebrations with your child, such as Christmas, Easter, Birthdays etc. Discuss: How do you feel on this day? Can you show me a happy/excited face?



Physical Development

Fine Motor Rainbow Challenge



*Explore the resources your child received in their Home Learning Pack. Challenge your child to make a lucky St. Patrick's Day Rainbow using the materials from the pack.

> (Pegboard, plastic counters, Unifix Cubes or the plastic links)

Language Development

* Talk to your child about St Patrick.

Why was he so special? What colour do
people wear to celebrate St Patrick's Day?

What is the name of the special leaf he
used to teach people about God?

Early Mathematical Experiences

*You could draw and cut out 5 shamrocks for your child to decorate. Model touching each one as you count together.

*See the 5 Green Shamrocks rhyme. Read the rhyme and ask your child to "pick" a shamrock each time. How many are left? Count together. Practice counting backwards from 5-1.
