



Home Learning Ideas Week beginning 22nd March 2021



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*We are learning about New Life in Spring and how animals and insects grow and change e.g. caterpillars turn into butterflies.

You could look at some baby photographs with your child. Discuss how they have changed since they were born. Ask questions:

What can you do now that you could not when you were born?



Early Mathematical Experiences

* You could cut out some paper 2d shapes in different colours. Discuss the different shapes with your child. Encourage your child to create a Spring Flower shape picture. Can they name any of the shapes they used to create their picture?



Physical Development

*Children love exploring bubble wrap and popping it is great for developing fine motor skills. You could use a marker to add black dots onto some bubble wrap to create "frogspawn" for your child to play with and pop!



The Arts

*The children love fingerpainting in Nursery. All you need is some bright coloured paint and paper. Talk to your child about Spring flowers (tulips, daffodils, bluebells etc) and their colours.

Language Development

* We are discussing how seeds begin to

grow during Spring. Listen to the story of
Jack and the Beanstalk.

Discuss how Jack's beans grew into a magic

the story in their own words, or you could



even act out the story together.
