



Home Learning Ideas Week beginning 29th March 2021

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

* You could help your child make their own Emotion Eggs - Use a marker to draw different faces onto plastic eggs. Model making up a short story using the eggs and talk about the emotions of the characters. Ask the children to make the correct face/find the correct egg for each emotion.



Physical Development

* Children love to mark make with a wide range of materials. You could encourage your child to mark make/write with the "Easter Bunny's Pen." All you need is carrots and some orange paint. Model how to make different marks on paper with the carrots.



Language Development

* We are learning and exploring new language related to Easter, such as young animal names and vocabulary related to growth. See the Easter word mat and discuss the images together.

The Arts

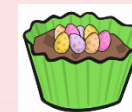
* Create some art with Kitchen Utensils! You could create Easter Eggs using a potato masher and discuss making patterns and colour mixing with your child.
