Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*May is the Month of Mary.



-Your child could draw a picture of Mary.

Physical Development

* Encourage your child to make marks in some Superhero Power Dust. All you need is a tray and add some flour and glitter/fairy dust. Encourage your child to make marks and patterns. Can they draw their favourite superhero?



Language Development
