Personal, Social & Emotional Development

*Pumpkins are decorated with lots of different faces, expressing different emotions. Ask your child to show you a happy, sad, silly, shocked, angry, sleepy, and grumpy face.



Physical Development

*See the Halloween Movement Game and challenge your child to create different Halloween themed movements.

E.g. Can you crawl like a spider?



Language Development

Early Mathematical Experiences

*Count together to 10. Jump and count, clap and count, hop and count etc.

*Create some Halloween decorations, such as this easy ghost craft. All you need is some paper, glue and cotton balls.
