Home Learning Ideas

Personal, Social + Emotional

In Nursery the children are learning how to share with their friends. This is one of our "Teddy Bear Rules." Talk to your child about the importance of sharing with others.

- See the Sharing Problem Picture. Discuss with your child. What should you do?

Physical Development

Pouring and Filling Activities help children develop their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.

-You could set up a box of water with different sized bowls and spoons. Add small toys (or Halloween items) for the children to scoop up.

Language Development

"Room on the Broom," is one of our favourite Halloween stories. You can listen to it on YouTube.

Ask questions- Who found the witch's hat? What did the dragon want to do? What was your favourite part of the story?



Mathematical Experiences

Cut out some paper shapes for your child: circle, triangle, rectangle, square, heart, star.



Ask questions- Can you find the heart?

Which shape is round?

The Arts

The children are learning the Halloween songs that were posted with the October Newsletter. Have a go at singing some of these songs at home.

The World Around Us

The children are learning about Halloween and festive traditions. Talk to your child about family traditions e.g., Dressing up, Trick or Treating, Carving Pumpkins etc.
