\* Listen to the story "**Well Done, Little Bear**" on YouTube which explores both these emotions.



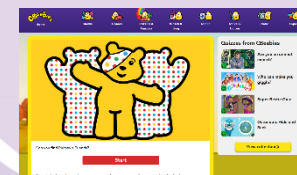
### **Physical Development**
