

Home Learning Ideas

Personal, Social + Emotional

* This month's emotion is Jealously.

Talk about feeling jealous. Explain that we all feel like this sometimes.

Discuss scenarios with your child. E.g.

Feeling left out when your friends are playing a game together. What could you do if you felt sad or jealous?



Physical Development

* Explore some songs about wild animal on YouTube. Encourage your child to join in with the words, actions, and movements. Can you move your body like each animal in the song?

*Talk to your child about their favourite wild animal.

Which do you like the best and why?

Discuss the features of the animal: size, colour, skin pattern etc.

Your child could create an animal mask using a paper plate and paint/markers.

* Discuss with your child how animals live in all different places around the world.

Ask your child to talk about or draw animals you might find on the farm, animals you might find under the sea and animals you might find in the zoo/wild.
