



Home Learning Ideas Week beginning 23rd November 2020



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*We are talking to the children about the excitement of the Birth of Jesus and reading the Christmas Story.

-Read the Nativity Story with your child or explore a version of the story on YouTube.



Physical Development

*Children love stickers, and you can use them in lots of ways. Peeling stickers from the paper provides a great opportunity to develop fine motor skills and develops pincer control.



Language Development

* The skill of writing begins with mark making. Through their marks, your child is communicating their ideas, expressing their feelings, and developing their imagination and creativity.

Early Mathematical Experiences

* In Nursery we are learning about the language of height in our play; short, shortest, tall, tallest, taller etc

Challenge your child. Can they make a tower that is taller than yours with their favourite construction materials?



The Arts

* We are learning about the Christmas Star and singing the song, "Twinkle Twinkle Christmas star." Ask your child to sing it for you!

You could get creative in the Kitchen together and make a Christmas Star cookie.

The World Around Us

* The children are learning about the Nativity and Christmas Traditions. Talk to your child about family traditions e.g. Setting out the Nativity scene, putting up the tree etc.

-Explore the Christmas Word Mat and talk about the pictures.
