Personal, Social and Emotional Development

*The emotions we are focusing on this month are "Surprised" and "Excited."

* Talk to your child about different feelings that they may experience at Christmas time. Ask them to show you their surprised and excited faces.

Physical Development

*The children are developing their scissor skills in Nursery.

*You could give your child some different types of wrapping paper and ribbons alongside some scissors. They can practise their scissor skills as they are snipping and cutting.

encourage imaginative play, promote
language skills as the children describe
the different objects and promote fine
motor skills (pouring, scooping etc)

Language Development

* Show your child the Christmas
"Can You Find?" Poster.

*Ask questions e.g. Can you find the bauble/gingerbread man/milk? Etc Encourage your children to talk about the object that they find and their position on the poster.
