Home Learning Ideas

Personal, Social + Emotional

* You could help your child make their own Emotion Eggs - Use a marker to draw different faces onto plastic eggs. Model making up a short story using the eggs and talk about the emotions of the characters. Ask the children to make the correct face/find the correct egg for each emotion.



Physical Development

* Pouring and Filling Fun - The children love pouring and filling activities in Nursery. Pouring and Filling activities develop children's hand-eye coordination and fine motor skills. If you have any plastic eggs at home, you could put them in a tray with some rice, flour or water.



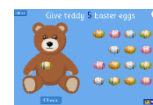
Language Development
