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# Traffic in School Grounds

A reminder that **no vehicles** should enter the upper playground at drop off or collection times unless special permission has been granted by the school. If you feel you may be eligible for special circumstances, please contact the school office.

# **Punctuality**

It is important that your child is in school on time. This ensures pupils are informed of the structure of their school day and are settled for lessons to begin. Doors open at 8:40 am and school begins at 8:55 am. Any pupil arriving after 8:55 am will be given a late mark which is recorded on our data system alongside attendance. Ensure you allow enough time each morning for your journey to school.

# Pupil Absences

All absences need to be coded accurately on our computer system. School should be kept informed of all pupil absences so accurate details are kept and appropriate procedures followed.

Contact the school office on the first morning of any pupil absence. Please note that any absences which fall below 85% (other than for medical reasons) are automatically referred to the Education Welfare Service.

## **Homework**

Your child's homework routine will be indicated by each class teacher. Parents/carers should ensure:

- All homework is handed in on time.
- Homework is completed neatly and accurately.
- Homework is signed by a parent.

It is important that all homework (including homework completed during Activity Club) is checked and signed by a parent.

## Medical Needs

Forms are available from the school office. Please ensure that inhalers are supplied for pupils already registered as having asthma. \*\*Nut Allergy please be advised that NO NUTS (or items containing nuts) SHOULD BE BROUGHT INTO SCHOOL. Your co-operation in this is important and much appreciated.

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## Water

Pupils may drink still, unflavoured water during the school day - no other drinks are allowed in bottles on desks. Please ensure all bottles have a pop up lid.

# Playground Equipment

Playground equipment, including the agility trail and castle tower, should only be used under school staff supervision. Children should not use this equipment at drop off or collection times.
