Friday - woodwind.

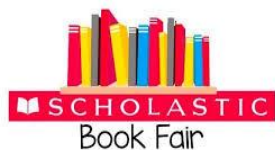


P6/7 Intergenerational Project

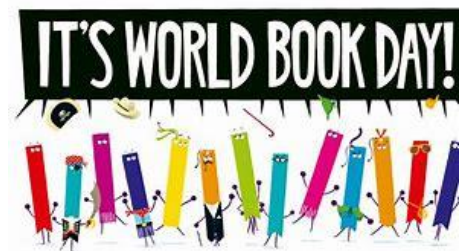
P1 Health Appraisals
