#### **Evidence**

The Communication Trust summarise the importance of communication in saying 'Chil find communication hard find life hard'. Children with speech and language delays are at high risk of difficulties with reading, writing and spelling. They are also more likely to have behavioural difficulties, difficulties making and maintaining friendships and with their self-esteem and confidence.
