Monthly Language Message

Sing a rhyme anytime Start your child learning for a life time!

Evidence

Fox et al (2001) show a strong link between rhyming and reading.

Enhanced rhythm and infant directed speech allows for speech segmentation which allows children to learn predictable patterns of speech. Rhythm "boots up" phonology (speech sounds) - Leong & Goswani (2015).

(Change the end to different parts of the body)


Sit Down Song

Humpty Dumpty Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall,


Humpty Dumpty had a great fall. All the King's horses, And all the King's men, Couldn't put Humpty together again.
