Evidence

De Casper & Fifer (1980) – the foetus can hear by the 3rd trimester of pregnancy and neonates can recognise their mother's voice. Talking to the baby in the womb also develops the attachment between the parent and the child. NCB (2017) A mother's experiences antenatally impact on maternal and infant mental health.

Talking to unborn babies while they are still in the womb may improve their language skills later in life, scientists have discovered.

The sound of a mother's voice is one of the first sensory experiences a tiny baby has as they develop in the womb. Lahav (2015)
