Could be drama/music/art related. Our focus will be on nursery aspect of their school. Topics could include food, art techniques - printing. Workshops will take place based on art techniques and puppets. Details from the host school will be forwarded before the meeting in April.

TLA - Bulgaria - 21st - 27th May 2017 - 2 members of staff will engage proposed quilling and dance workshops. Attend maths lessons and art lessons. Activities and proposed workshops etc will be discussed and forwarded nearer to the date.

Activity A6- Art calendar - a calendar created by the pupils using local art/sculpture found in the vicinity of school. Upload 2 pictures of local art/sculpture to be sent to Kersti. Include special dates for Ireland for 2017 e.g Easter, St.Patrick's Day, Public holidays etc.

Activity A7 - Discovering our local area - pupils produce a travel guide (digital?) for museums, art galleries, tourist attraction in their locality and in the north of Ireland, e.g Top ten tourist attractions - can include links to the various attractions. To be completed by June 2017. Aim for late May/early June due to move.

Activity A8 - creating artistic canvas bags - can purchase bags, decorate, emboss etc. Link to entrepreneurial aspect of the project. To be completed by May 2017.

Activity A10- Poetry across the borders - children create poetry on common themes to share with each other - focus on rhyme - could be food, traditions, friendship, art, weather etc. To be completed by June 2017.
