Project summary: Our project is art and history based, exploring different cultures/traditions through sculpture and art.

We aim to use art/history as a universal means of learning and communication between partner countries.

Fully inclusive project, aims to enhance skills in Literacy, Numeracy, ICT, World Around Us and The Arts.

Project will introduce pupils and teachers to our European platform.

TPM - PROJECT PLANNING MEETING- 10 October- 12 October Norrköping SWEDEN

3 members of staff (Emma, Maria and Nicola) travelled to our partner school, in Kolmarden, Norrköping. At the meeting, activities were discussed and agreed for the forthcoming year. Activities to be completed in 2018/2019 are detailed below.

LTTA - ZAGREB, CROATIA 1 April - 5 April .

Monday 1st to Friday 5th April. This will be a week-long visit to our partner school. 2/3 visiting staff need to demonstrate something that they can teach to partner staff/pupils. Aim is to share skills/different teaching methods/group work/classroom management/resources. Could be history/drama/music/art related. Workshops will take place during the visit which will have some cultural/educational aspect. Details of visit were shared with partner schools at TPM in Norrköping.

Final Project Planning Meeting - GALWAY 20-22 May

This meeting will involve 3 staff members and will focus on the requirements of the final report form required by the British Council. Draft forms will be completed during this meeting by participants and agreed before submission to the British Council for a deadline of August 2019.

Project activities - GANTT CHART 2018-2019

Activity A5 - Create Christmas cards based on a traditional art theme from your country. Each country will create a selection of Christmas cards and post a selection to each partner country.

Received Christmas cards will be disseminated throughout the school.

Activity A12- Theatre in our land- understanding how theatre influences our culture

Each partner country will make a small theatrical show based on something familiar/of interest/from a familiar/traditional story. Can use ICT /apps/movie makers/dramatization/puppetry to retell stories or playscripts.

Finished products to be uploaded to Google Drive and eTwinning portal by 31st January 2019. Partner countries will share completed activities with their pupils. Photographs and word document explaining process and outcome to be included in this activity.

Activity A14- Dance and Music

Express emotions through art of dance and music - explore how music and dance from our country inspires us and evokes emotion.

Showcase dances/songs for partner countries. Could link to Speech and Drama Festival/St.Patrick's Day celebrations.

Final product to be uploaded to eTwinning portal and Google Drive by April 2019. Completed dances/songs to be shared with pupils.

Activity A15 - Art inspired by nature

Create pictures using pieces of nature e.g leaf and twig pictures/snow characters, and capture images using camera.

Could be incorporated into Gardening Club activities. To be completed by June 2019.

Activity A16 - Traditional Food from our area

Pupils talk about and create a few traditional foods from our area, eg, scones, wheaten bread etc. Children write the recipe for the chosen food and the instructions on how to make it. Photograph each part of the process and the finished product. Could link with our Fabulous Food Club on Fridays. To be completed by April 2019.

Activity A17 - Street Art workshops

Partner countries can explore the historical/cultural aspects of street art and if possible engage in a local street art project. (Jason Diamond from ABC Council could link us with a street/graffiti artist)

E.g Every year our Galway partner school knit woollen squares in school and they use the squares to cover a famous historical monument in their city.

Final pieces to be uploaded and shared on eTwinning and Google Drive by March 2019.

A18 - T Shirt designs

Countries can design T shirts with common theme of friendship. Use slogans and create designs using culture of each country. T Shirts can be exchanged with pupils from our partner schools at meeting in Croatia in April 2019. Can include entrepreneurial aspect - making profits etc.

Activity A19 - Flash Mob performance/Lip Sync to song chosen by partner countries e.g Bruno Mars "count on me"

Finished performance to be uploaded to Google Drive and etwinning platform by June 2019.
