Girls' uniform consists of:

- Blue and white checked shirt
- Grey pleated/plain pinafore/skirt or grey trousers
- Grey/white socks or tights
- Plain black school shoes or plain black runners

Boys' uniform consists of:

- Blue round neck sweater with school crest
- Blue and white checked shirt
- Grey trousers
- Grey socks
- Plain black school shoes or plain black runners



- On P.E. days, pupils wear plain navy tracksuit bottoms, a white polo shirt, their school jumper and plain black runners. Pupils are asked to wear non-marking runners.
- Please note that jewellery is not allowed. Only stud earrings are allowed.
- Pupils are permitted to wear a wide-brimmed hat to school, particularly during spells of hot, sunny weather.
