Stationery and School Requisites 2024/25

Stationery:

The cost of all new textbooks, workbooks and copies that each child receives this year is paid for by the Primary Schoolbooks Scheme introduced in 2023. The lists of stationery outlined below is a guide to help ensure that each child has all the resources that they will need throughout the school year.

School Requisites:

A payment of €40 for each child is asked to cover the cost of 24-hour insurance, photocopying, art and craft materials and standardised tests.

Junior Room:

Junior Infants, Senior Infants and 1st Class

Please ensure that your child has each of the following items for this school year:

If you can, please sharpen pencils at home as much as possible.

Please label each stationery item with your child's name. Please secure labels that may fall off throughout the school year with clear tape. Please label all uniform jumpers, drinks bottles, lunch boxes, hats and coats.

No colouring pencils for Infants please. Crayons should be the thicker type for Junior Infants for easier grip or twistables. No markers please.

Copies will be provided as necessary for the children throughout the year
